The St. Lawrence Centre Arena will be hosting its 15th annual Spring 3-On-3 Hockey League beginning Monday, April 16th, 2012 running through Saturday, June 16th. The league will include weekly games and a single elimination playoff tentatively scheduled for the week of Monday, June 11th, concluding on Saturday, June 16th.

Teams will consist of a minimum of seven to ten players including one goalie. Each team must also have one adult to act as a supervisor/coach. This person does not have to be a USA Hockey registered coach.

Game Times: Peewee, Bantam, and Midget Minor division league games will be played full-ice, one game each week, Monday through Friday between 5:15 pm and 9:15 pm. Mosquito, Mite, and Squirt division league games will be played cross-ice on Saturdays between 8:30 am and 6:30 pm. All games will consist of three thirteen-minute running time periods. Games may be played during the week for playoffs.

Ages/Divisions: The league will follow USA Hockey age classifications for the 2011-2012 season located on the registration form. Exceptions can be made but only with permission from arena management.

Jerseys: Players are responsible for supplying their own jerseys. Schedules will be posted once registration is complete and will indicate if your team will be wearing white or dark jerseys for each game.

Cost: The cost of the league for Mosquito, Mite, and Squirt division players will be \$90.00 US per player. Peewee, Bantam, and Midget Minor division players will be \$105.00 US per player. If you are registering a team, a \$50.00 non-refundable deposit must be paid to hold your spot. The deposit can then be applied toward any players registration fee.

To register a team

You Must Contact the Arena ASAP. The number of teams per division is limited and will fill quickly. Reservations are made on a first come – first serve basis. You will need to submit a team roster and the non-refundable deposit in order to reserve spot. Each team member's registration form must be fully completed and submitted with payment no later than April 6th.

To register as an individual

To be placed on a team you must complete the registration form in full and submit with payment to the arena office no later than April 6th. Placements, where available, are made on a first come – first serve basis and cannot be guaranteed. In some cases we need a parent to act as a coach for a team that we create from individuals. If interested please let us know.

Payment information: We do not recommend sending cash in the mail. Payments can be made in person at the arena office or mailed in. We accept cash, check, money order, visa and mastercard. 3-on-3 League Rules

The St. Lawrence Centre Arena reserves the right to add, delete or modify rules and regulations contained in this packet and those applicable to the general operation of the facility. The decision of the arena management shall be binding and final.

- 1.) **Players** – ALL players participating in the league must have a signed registration form/waiver.
- 2.) **Slapshots** – There will be no slapshots allowed for the Mosquito, Mite, and Squirt divisions. Slapshots are allowed in the Peewee, Bantam, and Midget Minor divisions.
- 3.) **Checking** – There will be no checking allowed in any division.
- 4.) **Length of Game** - There will be (3) thirteen-minute running periods. A three minute warm-up will be provided before each game. Teams must be prepared to take the ice as scheduled or face the possibility of a forfeit. There will be no overtime during league games.
- 5.) **Penalties** – All penalties will result in a penalty shot. For cross-ice: play will resume immediately after the penalty shot with no stoppage of play. Full-ice divisions: a face-off at center ice will occur only when the penalty shot is scored, otherwise play will continue as described by a save (see: “Goals and Saves” rule.) Players charged with a penalty shall sit out a shift and be replaced with another player. Teams will always remain at full strength. Players drawing excessive penalties may be ejected from the game.
- 6.) **Offsides** – For full-ice divisions: Tag-up offsides will be permitted. Center ice line does not exist.
- 7.) **Goals and Saves** – If a team shoots on net and scores or the puck is covered by the goalie that team must back up a reasonable distance to allow the other team to play the puck out of the net. Full-ice: all 3 players must tag up with the blue line before they re-enter the offensive zone.
- 8.) **Icing** – There will be no icing called. Excessive icing may result in a delay of game penalty.
- 9.) **Puck Leaving Boundary** – For cross-ice divisions only: In the event of a puck leaving the boundary the team first to the puck will take control and be allowed to bring it back in. Referee will use his or her judgment during this particular situation. Players are asked to remain along the blue line at all times and make an effort to keep the puck in play.
- 10.) **No Fighting** - Fighting will not be tolerated. First offense will result in players out of the game. A second offense will result in players out of the league.
- 11.) **Substitute Players** – Substitute players will be charged \$10.00 US per player for cross-ice, \$12.00 per player for full-ice, per game. Subs must be placed on the team roster and submit a completed registration form no later than 5:15 pm on Monday, April 16th. Substitute players are not eligible for the Playoffs, so ensure you have enough players on your team in the event a few players are unable to attend the playoff games.

*** Due to the unique nature of 3-on-3 hockey, game situations will arise where a referee, at his or her own discretion, will have to make a number of judgment calls. Therefore, in all cases THE REFEREE’S CALL WILL BE FINAL!**
